

What is ImPACT?

ImPACT is a computerized neurocognitive test administered on a desktop, or laptop computer in about 20 minutes. **ImPACT** has two primary uses: before the onset of an activity, a baseline test is conducted to measure an individual's cognitive performance baseline. In the event of an injury, a post-injury test is administered and compared to the baseline and/or normative data scores.
